Universal Chrome Minerals (UCM) intends to develop a chrome processing plant on portion 50 of farm Boschfontein 458 JQ near Brits Town. The plant site is located within the Madibeng Local Municipality under the Bojanala Platinum District Municipality. The plant is situated within the A21J Quaternary Catchment Area, and the activities will include stockpiling, crushing, screening, washing, and loading of chrome minerals.

UCM is applying for a Water Use Licence (WUL) in terms of the National Water Act (NWA, Act 36 of 1998), as defined in Sections 21 (a), (b), and (g) of the Act. The application for WUL has been lodged with the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS), as an identified Competent Authority.

Furthermore, UCM also intends to apply for Section 24G rectification under National Environmental Management Act (NEMA, Act 107 of 1998) for the unlawful clearing of indigenous vegetation at the proposed processing plant site which contravened the following listed activities:

- Activity 27 under notice 1 of GN 327 of EIA Regulations 2017, and
- Activity 12 under notice 3 of GN 324 of EIA Regulation 2017.

The following additional listed activities under NEMA EIA regulations and National Environmental Management: Waste Act (NEMWA, Act 59 of 2008) will also be triggered by the development of the processing plant and will require an Environmental Authorisation:

- Activity 28 under notice 1 of GN 327 of EIA Regulations 2017
- Category B of NEMWA GN R.1094 of 2017, as amended: Activity 2, 7, 10 and 11.

This notice is thus given in terms of the requirements of the above-mentioned legislations and their associated regulations and serve as an invitation to all Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) to take part in the public participation process. In addition to other means of engaging I&APs, a public meeting will be held as follows:
